

Holy Renovations, Batman! We're leveling up!

If you have been in the sanctuary any time in the last few months, you will have noticed some things are moving around and changing.

Beginning with the pews!

We did some re-arranging to make the sanctuary more welcoming to persons who use a

wheelchair. Pews were moved so there is space in every aisle for a wheelchair to navigate. We also moved some smaller pews to the center on the left hand side so there is room for a person who uses a wheelchair to sit comfortably without having to settle for a seat in the very back or very front. We also removed the front row of pews so there will be more room for musical groups, like the Pentecost Band.

Once we got the pews situated it was time to look at the flooring. It has been a very long time since the carpet in the sanctuary was installed, so that will be replaced with as close to the same color as possible. But only up to the first pew. The floor between the first pew and the Communion Table will feature the beautiful wood that has been covered up by carpet. This will improve acoustics as well as being visually pleasing. The wood will be refinished before the new carpet goes in. That means there will be a period of time between tearing the carpet out and putting the new carpet in when our sanctuary is not going to look its best. But the end result will be so worth it!

All of this will cost more than is in our budget for 2020. We have received a generous donation toward the carpet replacement, but we will need everyone to help raise the rest of the money we need. There are fundraising details elsewhere in the newsletter. Just be aware that **any** size gift is welcome, from a handful of change on up.

This is so exciting! We are Leveling Up, making more space for everyone in our church. A little construction mess is a small price to pay to accomplish our goal of living into our commitment to being a church where All really does mean ALL.
